Main House —

Approx. 1850 sq ft, built in 2002

The Main House consists of 2 bedrooms, 2 baths, large walk-in closet. Each bedroom has sliding glass doors to surround porches with hot tub just a few steps away in the west garden. Cathedral wood ceiling in living room/family room area, with large 2 story library shelving and Rumford Fireplace overlooking level & cross-fenced pasture-lands bordered by stately Douglas Fir and Cypress forests and the Mendocino Forest Ridge-line in the far off distance.

- Munchkin flash boiler with superstore hot water tank and hydronic floor heat
- Acid etched concrete floors
- All decks are Trex on redwood and treated frames
- Plenty of storage closets throughout home
- Plus laundry room, pantry with wash sink and separate entrance
- Freshly painted interior in 2016
- Large attic with plywood sub-floors and lights. Could potentially turn into a loft or den space.



Guest/Caretaker's Residence

1961 original farmhouse, stucco with a metal roof.

3 bedroom and 1 bath

Living room, dining room, kitchen and separate mud room entrance.

- Ocean view from living room and main bedroom
- Original wood floors
- Double pane windows
- Wood Stove
- Propane heat
- Washer, dryer hookup
- Bathtub, shower
- Freshly painted interior in 2016
- Each bedroom has a closet, plus a hallway closet
- Has its own PGE meter, its own septic system
- Shares propane with main house, could easily separate
- Currently, this house is listed at the county as a storage barn, but it may be possible to convert to farmworkers' housing or a 2nd residence. Prior to current owners it was the main house (3 bedrooms) and what is now referred to as the main house (2 bedrooms) was the farmworkers housing. Previous owners rebuilt the farmworkers housing and made it their main residence. Current owners have used it for guest stays and Airbnb. Currently, they pay transient occupancy tax' when they rent it out.



With Art Studio Loft Spacious & High ceilings

- Cement slab floor with radiant floor heating (hydronic), stainless steel insulated roll-up doors

- Current owners have used the space for their farm stand and storage. Can also house tractors, boats, etc.
- Roof overhangs on 2 sides by approx. 12' each side for carport, boat storage, outdoor covered pens. Outdoor shower and abalone and fish cleaning area for the sports diver.

Art Studio Loft

Music room, home gym, office, meeting room, yoga studio, etc.

- Current owners have used it for workshop space, office and product development and for family visits.
- Carpeted throughout
- Large picture windows look out onto pastures and Mendocino Forest on one side and park with spring and pond on the other.
- Propane heat and ceiling fans
- Current owners put in a half bath and sinks without permits
- Cathedral ceiling with exposed steel and wood ceiling
- Electric circuit wired to avoid line noise for music recording









Red Agricultural Barn

New 36' x 48' ag barn built with wood milled right off the ranch includes:

- Tack room
- Chicken coop
- Root and wine cellar with hidden stairs depending within
- Drying room for herbs
- Plenty of room for hay and feed, stalls, equipment storage and/or livestock pens

Workshop & Wool Mill

Newer 30' x 50' barn with:

Pump House

Plenty of water on this ranch. In the east fields, there are 2 wells, the southeast field has year round spring which collects in cement vault and overspill runs down creek to Moat Creek. All buildings and livestock fields are currently watered by a large spring system that collects in a 3000-gallon tank and then overspills to the pond which then overspills to a creek that runs through the property towards Point Arena Creek.
