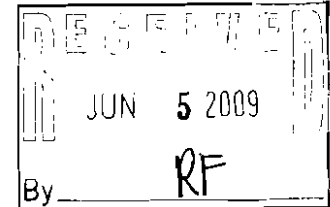

This Department has received and reviewed the groundwater monitoring data submitted by Black Eagle Consulting, Inc for the 2008/09 monitoring season. After several years of inconclusive data due to below average precipitation periods, I would like to be the first to congratulate you for your perseverance and with some cooperation from Mother Nature; we now have acceptable monitoring results!

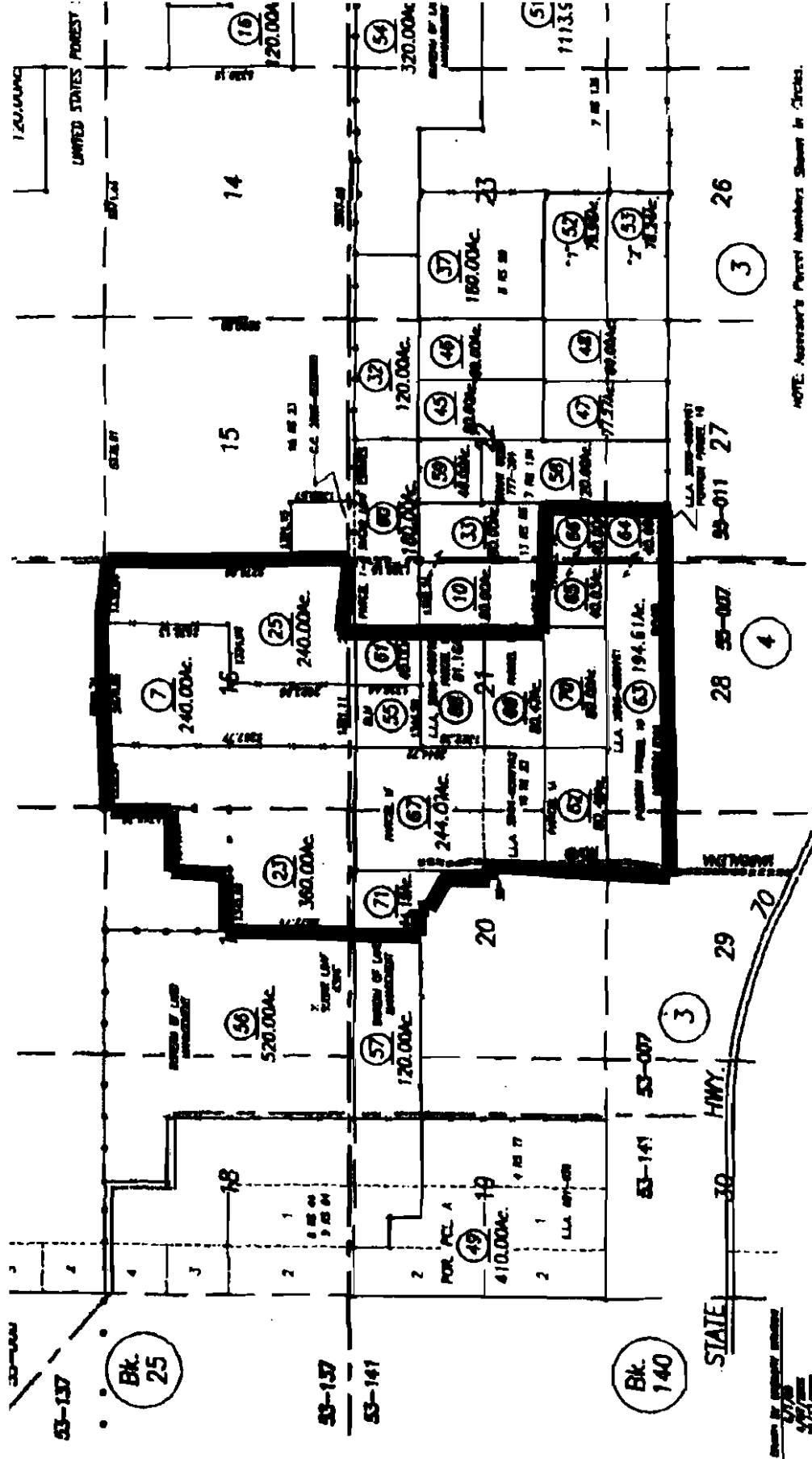
