## Location

This unrivaled location in San Mateo County in the San Francisco Bay Area provides easy access to nearby metropolitan areas. This property is equidistant (34 miles) from both the San Jose International and San Francisco International Airports. Oakland International Airport is 51 miles from the property. San Carlos Airport provides additional air service, 21 miles from the property, as well as Palo Alto Airport of Santa Clara County, 23 miles from the property. The closest school would be 0.72 miles away in the town of La Honda. From the north, take US-101 South to I-280 South. Take exit 24 to Sand Hill Road. 

#### **About Woodside:**






## San Mateo County and Weather





